

Copper Fountain by Craig

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This fountain is made by hand from copper. It is unique. I may make very similar ones but there will never be an exact copy.

The fountain has not been coated with a clear coat. It will turn a dark brown over time. If you wish to keep the copper colors, spray the entire fountain with a clear lacquer. The colors you see are a result of the heat from the oxy-acetylene torch used to make the fountain.

Operation:

Fill the bottom pan half full. Fill the top pan until it overflows into the second pan. Fill the second pan until it overflows. Fill the bottom pan up to one inch from overflowing. Plug in the pump and enjoy!

If it doesn't want to start, unplug the pump and wait 5 minutes. Plug in the pump and start again.

Keep the bottom pan at least half full. If the water level drops too low it will destroy the pump.

The fountain can be used indoors or outdoors. It may splash out of the pans. The flow rate can be adjusted on the pump.

Cautions:

When draining the fountain, bail out as much water as possible before picking it up or tipping it over.

The fountain may have sharp edges on the bottom of the pans. Be careful when handling. Wear gloves when handling.

Do not let it run dry. This will destroy the pump.

Do not let it freeze. This could damage the fountain.
